



PRIVACY POLICY

1. GENERAL

This Privacy Policy Statement (“**Privacy Policy**”) explains how Woosh Water Systems Ltd. and/or its affiliates (collectively, “**WOOSH**” or “**We**”) collect, use, share, protect and may disclose under certain circumstances, your information and it applies to your use of the website located at the following domain address: www.wooshwater.com (the “**Web Site**”). Your use of the Website is also governed by the terms of use published in the Website (the “**Terms of Use**”). In the event of any conflict between the terms of this Privacy Policy and the terms of the Terms of Use the terms of Terms of Use shall prevail.

We are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy and any information that you may provide us. Please read this Privacy Policy carefully before using the Web Site and review it periodically for the latest information about our privacy practices. By using or browsing the Web Site, you fully agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy.

2. THE INFORMATION WE COLLECT

When you use of (including any browse through or access of) the Web Site, we may gather certain information, including the following information:

- *Personally Identifiable Information* – This is information that may identify a person such as: first name, last name, E-mail address and phone number. 3. HOW WE USE THE INFORMATION

We may use the information we collect and store for the following purposes: (i) to provide, maintain and improve your user experience and Web Site operation; (ii) to send you communications and administrative emails and to provide users with further information and updates with regards to WOOSH’s products, technology, etc; (iii) to send you newsletter and/or marketing messages relating to any of WOOSH products (collectively, “**Marketing Message(s)**”). We may do this electronically, for example by email. You may tell us at any time if you do not

wish to receive Marketing Message from us by contacting us through our online contact form, available at <https://www.wooshwater.com/contact-us>] and by following any instructions we may include in the message we send to you. For example, a STOP message will appear at the foot of marketing text or email messages we send you. If required by applicable laws, we will obtain your prior consent by requesting you to check the relevant box in our Web Site; (iv) for analytics research purposes; (v) to prevent fraud, resolve disputes, troubleshoot problems, assist with any investigations, enforce the Terms of Sale, establishing your use of the Web Site and performing activities through the Web Site, disclaimers and limitations of liability governing the use of our Web Site, and take other actions otherwise permitted by law; and/or (v) for any other purposes as set forth in this Privacy Policy and/or the Terms of Use.

4. DISCLOSING OF ANY INFORMATION TO OUTSIDE PARTIES

We share Personal Identifiable Information and Non-Personally Identifiable Information collected via the Web Site with other companies or individuals as follows: (i) third parties who provide a service to WOOSH, such as with vendors that assist WOOSH in sending email, marketing and customer service (including their sub-contractors), on the understanding that they will keep the information confidential; (ii) third parties if WOOSH has a good faith belief that access, use, or disclosure of such information is reasonably necessary to (a) satisfy applicable law, regulation, legal process or an enforceable governmental request, (b) enforce the applicable WOOSH's Terms of Use, including investigation of potential violations thereof, (c) detect, prevent, or otherwise address fraud, security or technical issues, or (d) protect against harm to the rights, property or safety of WOOSH, its users or the public as required or permitted by law; (iii) any of WOOSH subsidiaries, joint ventures, or other companies under common control with WOOSH, in which case WOOSH will require them to honor this policy. Additionally, in the event WOOSH goes through a business transition such as a merger, acquisition by another company, or sale of all or a portion of our assets, your Personal and/or Non-Personal Identifiable Information may be among the assets transferred; and (iv) third parties to whom you ask WOOSH to send Personal and/or Non-Personal Identifiable Information.
